



Dog Import Requirements Into The US

 For Dogs Originating In Canada

Arrange Before Arriving at the Border
(Recommend 30 days prior)

At the Border

	Vaccination for rabies, distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parvovirus, and parainfluenza virus (DHLPP)
	Veterinary Certificate of Health and rabies vaccination signed by the veterinarian in the country of export.
	An Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) Issued Import Permit
	Seller/Breeder attestation letter
	Veterinary Health Certificate of Health signed by the veterinarian in the country of export - <i>no rabies statement needed</i>
	Microchipped*
	Formal U.S. Customs Entry - <i>if animal sent via common carrier</i>
	Visual Inspection of Animal
	Documentation Review
